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BACKGROUND FOR TERMS OF REFERENCE (ToR)

acciona.org Philippines Foundation Inc., also known as acciona.org Philippines, is a non-profit foundation established in the Philippines in 2022. Its main objective is to provide access to modern, clean, and safe forms of energy to low-income individuals in rural communities in the Philippines, in areas where there is no expectation of electric service through grid access in the short term. For this purpose, acciona.org Philippines offers access to basic electricity services through third-generation solar home systems (3GSHS) in the framework of the Light at Home program.

In collaboration with the Ayala Foundation and the Spanish Agency of International Cooperation for Development (AECID), since 2023, acciona.org Philippines has carried out the development of a project to benefit nearly 1,200 families in Palawan.

acciona.org Philippines is actively seeking a specialized consultancy in human rights, as part of its organizational commitment to achieve the highest ethical standards and social responsibility.

The objective is to align the organizational practices with the foundational principles of social justice. The consultancy will play a crucial role in guiding the organization toward the integration of human rights framework, ensuring compliance with established norms, and fostering equitable and inclusive practices.

The organization anticipates collaborating with professionals who share the dedication to these principles and are willing to contribute to foster the implementation of the highest ethical principles associated to acciona.org Philippines actions.

1. Objective of the consultancy

acciona.org Philippines recognizes the significance of human rights in the realization of a fair and inclusive society and is in need of a consultant to provide guidance on the integration of a human rights approach in its projects. This initiative seeks to ensure that organizational practices are associated with the principles of fairness, inclusivity, and adherence to the highest global human rights standards.

The primary objective of the consultant is to conduct a comprehensive evaluation and to give recommendations for a better alignment to the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights, published by United Nations in 2011. Specifically, the consultant will be required to:

- Conduct a review of related literature and assess the alignment of acciona.org Philippines
 projects to relevant international and local frameworks and legislation on human rights
- Design the methodology to measure the human rights impact of acciona.org Philippines projects, including key performance indicators, and carry out the actual evaluation
- Organize sensitization workshops or learning sessions to strengthen awareness and understanding of stakeholders on human rights issues
- Provide other inputs related to human rights as required

The deliverables must pass a formal process of acceptance by acciona.org Philippines to be qualified officially as delivered or completed. This determination will affect the payment periods associated with the consultancy. For the deliverables to be "accepted", the consultant is first required to submit a preliminary or draft version of the deliverable to acciona.org Philippines.

acciona.org Philippines will then conduct a thorough analysis of the draft version. Following this evaluation, a virtual meeting will be scheduled to facilitate the exchange of comments between the parties involved. Within a timeframe not exceeding 10 days, a final version of the deliverable is expected to be submitted for final acceptance.

Considering the period for review and revision of drafts, the total duration of the consultancy is approximately 16 weeks or 4 months.

3. Qualifications of Consultant or Consultancy Team

- With at least three (3) years experience in community development and human rights analysis and promotion; experience in international development cooperation projects is a plus
- With university degree relevant to the field
- With demonstrated understanding of issues related to access to electricity and water
- Able to produce high quality work with minimal supervision
- Proficiency in English and Filipino; demonstrated written and verbal communication skills
- Excellent interpersonal skills and able to work well in a multicultural environment

- Willing and able to travel
- Familiarity with project areas in Palawan is preferred

The goal is to adapt delivery dates precisely to the needs and circumstances, ensuring the effectiveness and success of the project.

5. Submission of Proposals

Interested parties should submit a detailed proposal with the following information:

- Company profile (and/or Curriculum Vitae of individual consultant or consultant team) that shows evidence of competency to carry out the engagement such as successful completion of similar work
- Technical proposal containing a brief description of the approach, methodology, and work plan reflecting the scope of works and the deliverables
- Financial proposal with key milestones for payments
 - A maximum of 20% of the quoted contract price may be requested as advance payment for mobilization funds, if required by the consultant.
 - o 40% of the price shall be paid upon acceptance by acciona.org Philippines of Deliverables 1 and 2. The remaining 40% shall be paid upon acceptance by acciona.org Philippines of Deliverables 3 and 4. Depending on the % of advance payment requested, the applicable percentages for deliverables should be adjusted accordingly.
 - The financial proposal should indicate an all-inclusive fee in Philippine pesos covering all expenses related to the performance of services under the contract such as remuneration, travel, insurance, taxes, among others.
 - o Payments shall be done via bank transfer.

6. Proposal Evaluation Criteria

acciona.org Philippines shall evaluate the technical and financial proposals as follows:

The consultant should score a minimum of 70 points for its proposal to be selected.

7. Responsibility of Consultant

Each consultant is responsible for the integrity of its proposal and performance. Non-compliance with the outlined stipulations may result in direct or indirect damages to acciona.org Philippines potentially causing reputational or financial losses and impeding the proper development of the Light at Home Palawan project. Violation of specified conditions may lead to legal action and contract termination. Upholding integrity and strict adherence to conditions are crucial for project success and transparency.

8. Cancellation of the Contract

acciona.org Philippines may temporarily or permanently cancel the selection process at any time by notifying each consultant by email.
